The River Thames was in good condition with varying flow dependant on the locks / boat traffic. The weather conditions were good. The Bream were feeding in the upper pegs on A section.

The match was won by Pete Budaji fishing triple maggot on an open feeder 3/4 of the way across the river. Pete caught Bream from the start to 8 pounds for a winning weight of 80 pounds exactly.

Second was Robbie Stevens who was slow to start catching bu finished strongly catching his Bream in the last 2 hours.

Third was George Callaghan with a similar Bream catch.

Tony Scott was 4th and only started catching after her changed to far bank feeder fishing methods, being hampered with pike on his earlier inside Roach line.

16 Anglers fished for a total weight of 217lbs

A specimen Perch was recorded of 3lb 0oz by Mark Hornblow.
